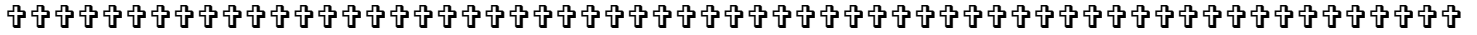


CHILDREN'S PROGRAM
