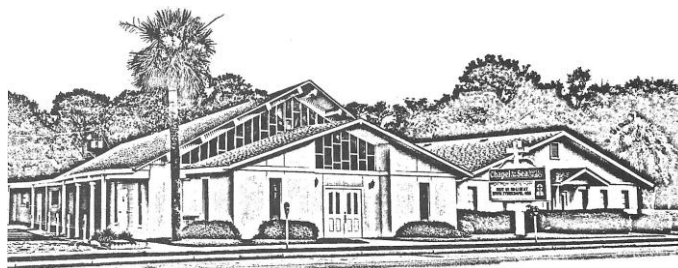

Wednesday, March 10th at 5:15 pm & Wednesday, March 24 at 5:15 pm.

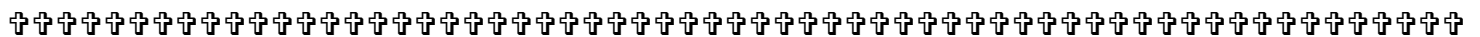

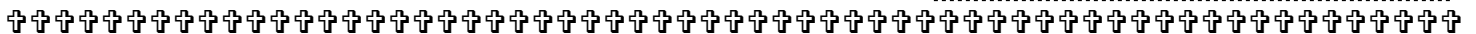
