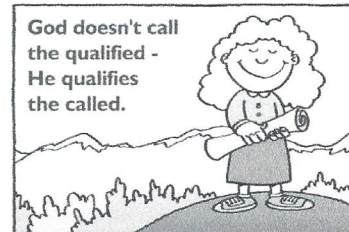
## God Can Use You

# Revealing Words

***“That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched – this we proclaim concerning the Word of Life.” I John 1:1***

Because Jesus is God’s revelation of Himself, He has a very special name: “The Word of Life” (I John 1:1). This same title opens John’s gospel: “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God” (John 1:1).

Why does Jesus Christ have this name? Because Christ is to us what our words are to others. Our words reveal to others just what we think and how we feel.
